Landon's Letters

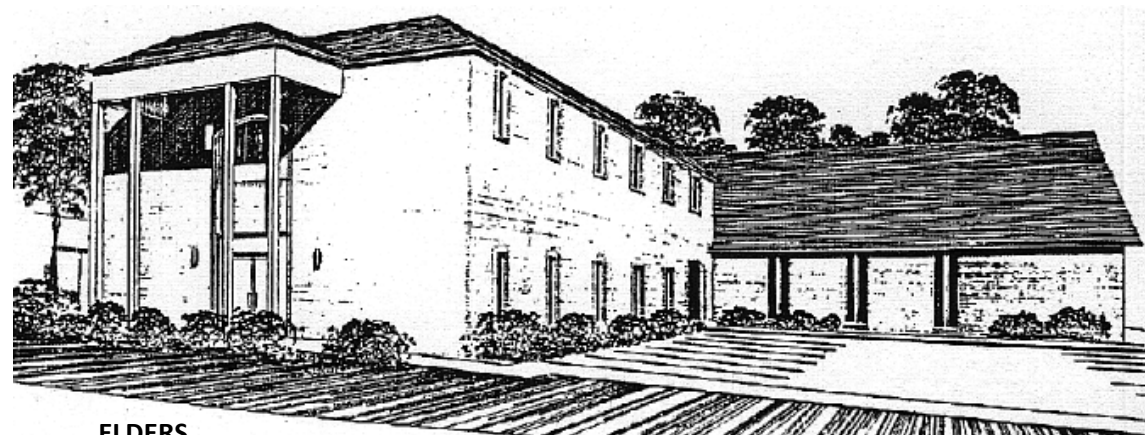
