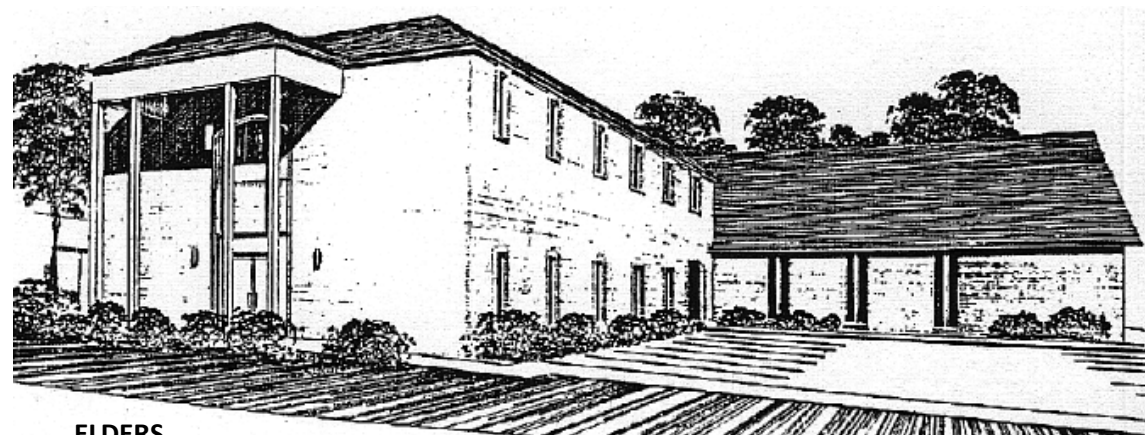
Now that the school year is fastly approaching there are going to be many things that our kids will be involved with! Be sure to be praying for them as they start back to school in a few weeks!
