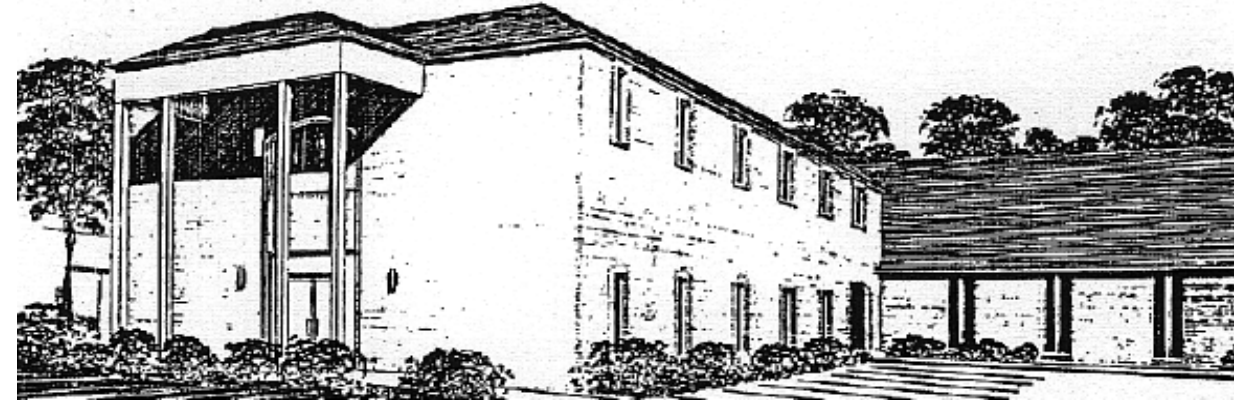
Husband – You got to find her. I don’t know what I will do without her.
