2 Corinthians 6:9-11 gives a list of sins that the Christian must not be associated with. There must be a separation from such lifestyles.

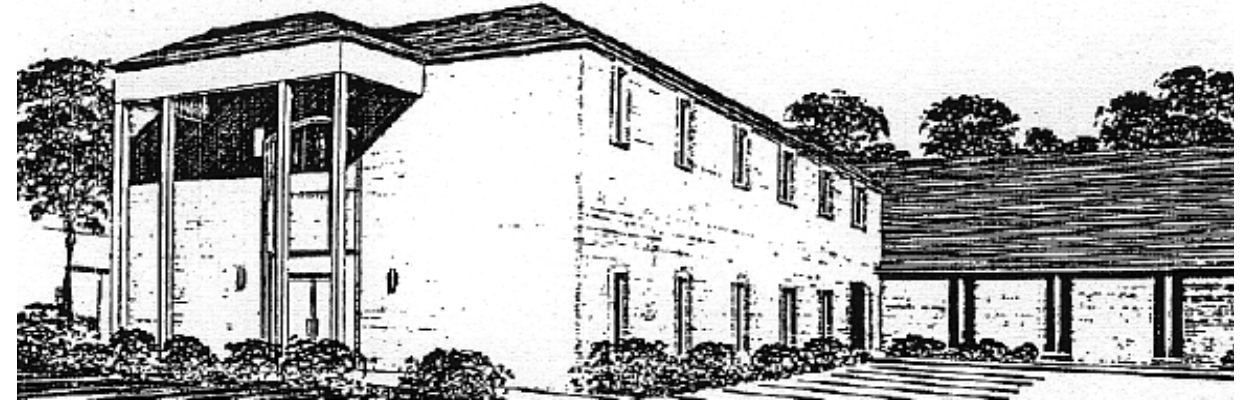
