June 14-17 – Vacation Bible School at Vernon.

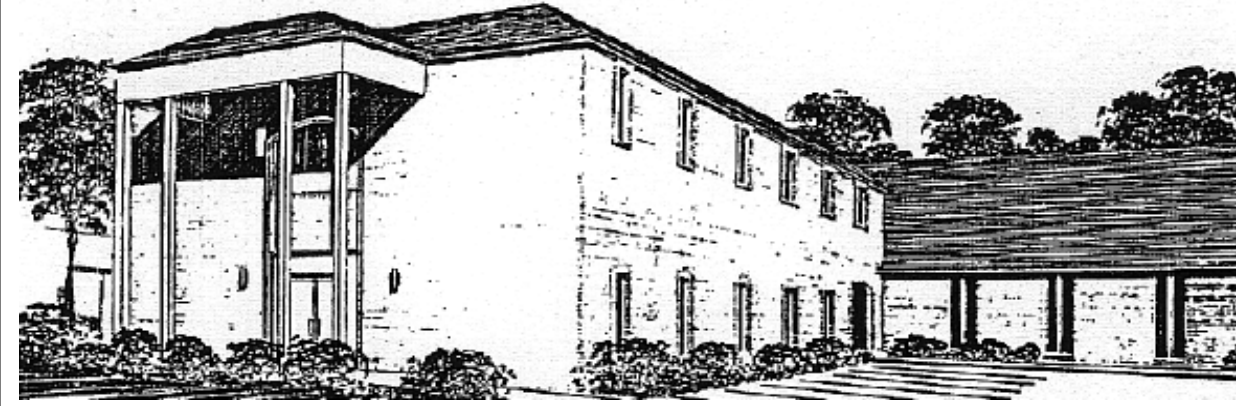
PEOPLE NEED GOOD NEWS
